Locally Picked a native source of caffeine

Yaupon is a member of the holly family, with evergreen leaves and waxy, red berries that ripen just in time for the December holiday season. The leaves are sustainably harvested, dried, and roasted to make a stimulating tea that contains caffeine, theobromine, and antioxidants.

Yaupon was highly esteemed by indigenous tribes and was referred to by some as the "white drink" as a symbol of purity and was used for peaceful purposes.

Yaupon is available from Wild Woods Farm in loose leaf, dried and roasted, by the pound, in 3-oz. bags, or as sampler tea bags. It is also available by the pound unroasted.

- loose leaf, roasted and ground \$12/3 oz
- fresh picked, unroasted, air-dried \$30/lb
- sampler tea bags, roasted & ground \$2/ea
