



Yaupon Tea

a native source of caffeine

Yaupon is a member of the holly family, with ever-green leaves and waxy, red berries that ripen just in time for the December holiday season. The leaves are sustainably harvested, dried, and roasted to make a stimulating tea that contains caffeine, theobromine, and antioxidants.

Yaupon was highly esteemed by indigenous tribes and was referred to by some as the “white drink” as a symbol of purity and was used for peaceful purposes.

Yaupon is available from Wild Woods Farm in loose leaf, dried and roasted, by the pound, in 3-oz. bags, or as sampler tea bags. It is also available by the pound unroasted.

- loose leaf, roasted and ground - \$12/3 oz
- fresh picked, unroasted, air-dried - \$30/lb
- sampler tea bags, roasted & ground - \$2/ea
